Den chiefs who qualify for the Den Chief Service Award wear the special Den Chief Award cord and may continue to wear it as long as they are Scouts or Venturers, even if no longer a den chief. Wear it with pride! You worked hard to earn it!



This Braid is worn by Scouts while serving as a Den Chief (Blue and Gold)



This Braid is worn by Scouts while serving as a Webelos Den Chief (Red, Blue, and Gold)

Each of these are worn over the left shoulder (under the epaulet and under the arm). A Scout that has earned the Den Chief Service Award, and is serving as a Den Chief or Webelos Den Chief, may wear both braids.



This Braid is worn by Scouts who have earned the Den Chief Service Award (Red, White, and Blue)
